I can recommend *Portrait Revolution* without reservation to anyone with a penchant for the visual arts in general and portraiture in particular. The book is a collection of selected pieces which were created as part of Julia Kay's Portrait Party, an online project of over 1000 artists which began in 2010 and is ongoing. It's not exactly a how-to book, but with anecdotes and reflections on the creative process from the artists themselves, it's more than just a coffee-table collection of artwork. The styles and mediums represented in these pages are incredibly diverse. One of my favorite features of the book is the showcasing of portraits done by different artists of the same subject, showing there are multiple ways to interpret the world. Julia Kay's Portrait Party is an incredibly vibrant and warm community of artists, and this book is an deliciously inspirational slice of cake from the party. Just flipping through the pages makes me want to put pencil to paper and dip my brushes in paint.
