

Burton H. Throckmorton, Jr. is Hayes Professor of New Testament Language and Literature, Emeritus, at Bangor Theological Seminary, Bangor, Maine. He received his B.A. from the University of Virginia and his B.D. from Union Theological Seminary in New York. He studied at the University of Marburg in Germany and earned his Ph.D. from Columbia University. He is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and in the United Church of Christ. Professor Throckmorton is a member of the Inclusive Language Lectionary Committee and is the author of numerous articles in the field of New Testament studies.

Excellent resource

Throckmorton's "Parallels" is a great text to see not only the textual comparisons, but also great to identify sources and NRSV translation notes. This is my frequently used "go-to" comparison to assist in exegesis of gospel text.

This is an excellent reference for comparing and contrasting what appears to be parallel stories and statements in the synoptic gospels. It is useful for Bible study that includes the use of biblical criticism.

Great for comparing the Gospels side by side! Good study tool. This book puts the synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke) side by side by side. It makes it easy to compare the gospels and see what one gospel includes that the others don't. Can be used to learn what each gospel author is focusing on.

Comes very handy. Unfortunately, the version with all four Gospels costs a lot more, but for the purposes of studying the historical Jesus you generally only really need to look at the Synoptic Gospels, so this is great.

This is a helpful reference book to have when studying the synoptics. It takes a while to get used to how Throckmorton structures this and how to find particular passages in the gospels. Nevertheless this provides a concise parallel of related passages between the synoptics and even notes variations by lining up each parallel verse.
