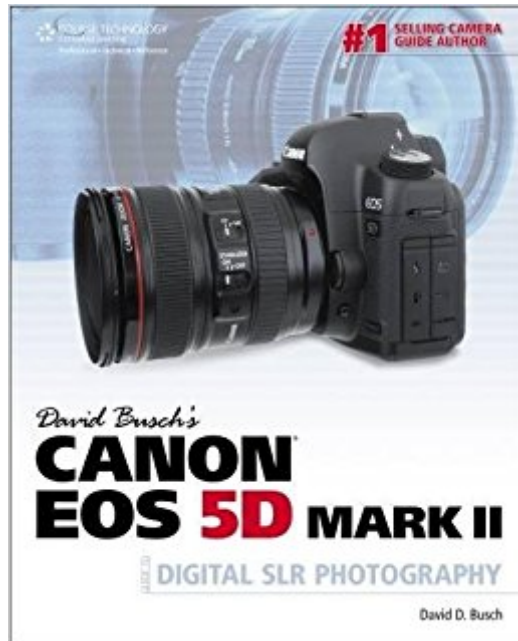

This is not my first David Busch publication, he has in my mind been able to capture the essence of taking a rank beginner and creating a near professional with his step by step approach in this book, just as he has in others. I purchased this book at the time I purchased my Canon 5D Mark II and I've never yet regretted the purchase. I come back to the book on occasion to look for tips or to bone up in certain areas of the abilities of the camera and I'm never disappointed. David's work flows so well and his explanations are very concise but user friendly. For the 5D Mark II I have found this publication to be a great field manual for all levels of photography. With David's help here I've been able to capture some excellent photos with my camera and developed a familiarity with it that I never expected. Definite recommendation.

I was a bit cautious about buying this book because a number of other reviews claimed it contained inaccuracies, particularly in relation to the Camera's flash capability. Perhaps this book has been revised since those reviews but my copy makes it clear that the flash is an accessory. Overall I found this book to be well written, comprehensive and generally easy to follow. The layout is excellent and it contains quite a few helpful tips. I would recommend it to anyone who is not a

professional photographer and who just wants to get a better understanding of the features of the camera. An excellent guide.

If you own a Canon 5D MkII or MkIII, this is the only manual that will get you through this most beautiful but complicated camera. The camera sits up at the top, along with one or two others, made by Canon. Also, being a, "Full Frame," format, the shooting capabilities of the camera, either, still or video, are endless. This is the Bible for not only the Canon 5DMkII but for all cameras, produced by Canon, Nikon, Pentax, Sony, and the many, many, others, available. David Bush will make sure you understand whatever questions or problems you may have with this most complicated of cameras, in the digital age. He has a knack, the know-how to get the info to us but more important, for us to understand what the information is saying. I could not get to first base when I purchased the Canon 5D MkII, until I bought David's book. Each chapter goes into just enough specifics, to understand, what this very technically advanced computer by Canon is saying. How to interpret the info, filter it, and to integrate what you read into the reality of actually using it and to make creatively beautiful pictures.

This is the first book I was so anxious to get that I preordered it. I am not disappointed. While anticipating the release of Busch's book, I studied other books by various authors on the 5D Mark II as well as David's Busch's books on other camera models. I knew this was the "one." There is really nothing more to add to the earlier reviews except I agree wholeheartedly with every positive comment. I might add however, that as a senior citizen, I appreciate the type style used and the very readable examples and illustrations. The excellent quality of the paper is also what would be expected in a manual for the wonderful 5D Mark II. The manual which came with the camera was frustrating to say the least and now I am confident that I am going to be able to utilize most if not all, of the advanced features of this wonderful camera. Although I had used a Canon 35mm for years and was familiar with photographic techniques, this camera and this manual have opened up a new world. After a great deal of research, it is satisfying to know that I chose the right camera and the right manual to go with it. Thanks, David.

I have purchased all the books I could find on the Canon 5D Mark II and this is by far the best for both content and quality of the physical book. If this had been published sooner I would have saved some \$ because it really explains things very well and is very well written. The camera does so many things I was not familiar with and David Busch does an excellent job in his explanations. Also

the book is in full color and uses excellent quality paper. This makes the book rather heavy for carrying around in your bag, but it still does not preclude me from having it with me when I am out in the field. I highly recommend this fine volume for anyone who owns the Mark II or is considering a purchase of one. By the way, the camera is fantastic as well.
