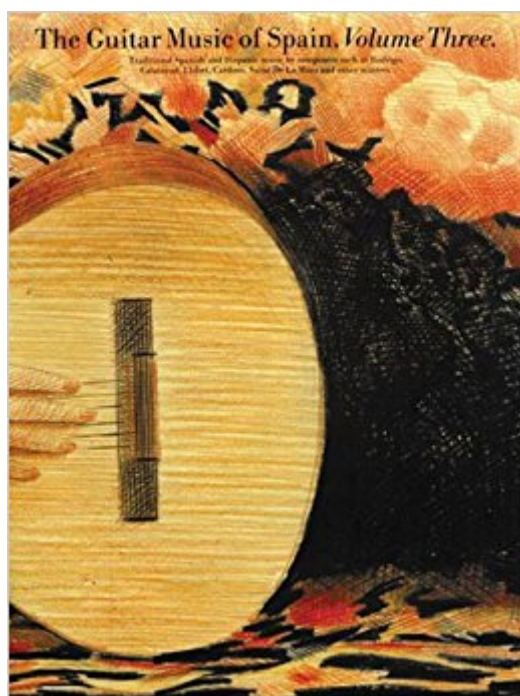

With the exception of a few pieces, most of the music in the book, I will never play. This is a case

where, if I had been able to view the content, I never would have purchased it. Jorge Cardoso, Bartolomé Calatayud and J. Nin-Culmell are not household names for classical guitar. The one piece by Tarrega is Capricho Arabe, of which I already have numerous editions. Both pieces by Torroba and Rodrigo appear without fingerings. I could go on, but I will suffice it to say, I am very disappointed with this book and do not recommend it to anyone.
