

This book is inspirational and has provided some ideas to try to incorporate into the farm garden landscape (using alternate plants that can tolerate the Texas heat). Also gave a copy to a fellow gardener who is delighted with the contents.

This is a gorgeously illustrated book with hundreds of ideas to inspire the gardener who wants to add architectural elements to their garden. Be aware, however, that this is mainly a collection of photographs and does not provide much in the way of how to actually go about constructing these projects yourself. The book is divided into sections covering fences, walks, hedges, structures, etc. Each section features an array of photographs which illustrate every conceivable aspect of the topic. The photos are beautiful and are the definite selling point of this book.
