

I love Suzanne Wrights books and waited impatiently for my preorder of this one to be delivered. Then I couldn't wait for a day off to read it straight through non stop. Overall I loved the story line but found the foul language and bathroom humor ruining my enjoyment of the book. Here are a couple examples of things that I felt could have easily been removed. There is a scene where the Alpha female is in labor. Just before she gives before, she starts asking why does it feel like she needs to take a sh++. Then she asks several more times right in a row if she took a sh++ as she is supposed to be finally having her son. Towards the end of the book, the main couple is Jaime wants to tease Dante while making love she says something along the lines of "Did I mention my cat gave my wolf worms?" Comments like those were so jarring to me that it instantly destroyed my enjoyment of the

book and made me want to skip ahead and move the next part of the book. There were a few other instances (Like the comment to Greta about how she makes Jaime want to fart as another reviewer mentioned" that could easily have been removed with out changing the book in the least. In fact removing them would have improved it in my opinion. While I have read all the other books by this author multiple times, I highly doubt I will reread this one again.

Jamie had a crush on Dante since she was a child. Dante is aware of Jamie's attraction but doesn't feel the same way about her. Jamie wasn't going to pant after Dante forever, when she hears something that hurt her, she didn't let it bring her down. Nope she decided he could kiss her wolf @\$\$ and she would find someone new.
