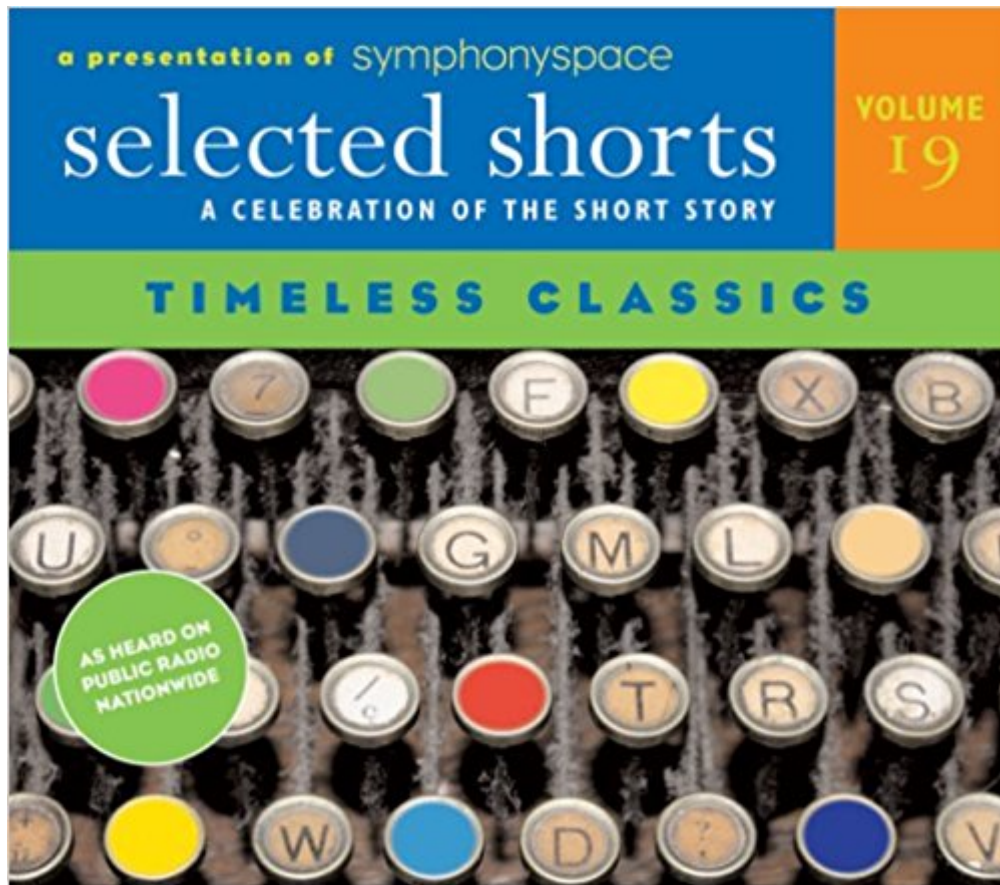

This is an audio collection of very good short stories performed extremely well. The reader of Carver's "Cathedral" is especially good, bringing out the humor of the story as well as the pathos of the narrator who after hosting and savaging a "blind man" all day realizes who really is blind. I also liked D.H. Lawrence's "Rocking Horse" story, a Twilight-Zone type story about magic, but which also explores the subtleties of family dysfunction and unhappiness."The Most Dangerous Game" is also

very well read. None of the readers overact or unduly inject themselves into the story. But they are all very intelligent and help to convey the story to the reader.
