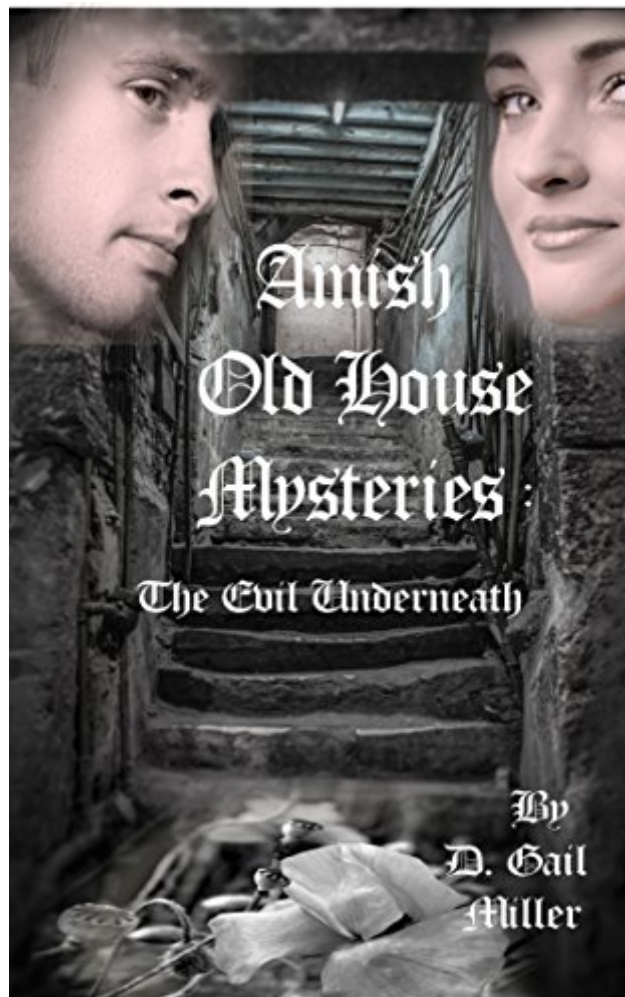

Hannah Gingerich has recently called off her engagement to Laban Detweiler. She mistakenly believes he was responsible for a cruel prank against his sister, Martha, who has Down's Syndrome. Martha is no longer her usual cheerful self and seems troubled. She mentions the name Mickey to Hannah, appearing to be scared of him. Hannah is determined to discover who Mickey is. Hannah's search leads her to an old deserted house in the woods, where she makes an unexpected discovery in the basement. This spurs her on to find out the truth about what happened to the previous owners Henry and Sheila Roberts. Although Hannah is aware that her neighbour, Ada Zook, likes Laban, she and Laban still have feelings for each other. Will Hannah's search bring her and Laban closer together, and what are Ada's true motives? Hannah is a kind considerate girl who is very inquisitive and loves to solve a mystery. Deeply concerned about Martha, she is determined to find out who upset her and why. This is a well written and intriguing mystery story with plenty of twists and turns. The book is aimed primarily at YA readers, however, I would recommend this for readers of any age. The writing is descriptive and imaginative and the author conveys very well the creepy atmosphere of the old house. A very interesting and enjoyable read.

Joyce Carol Oates had this criticism to say about the mystery genre, "Amongst the more churlish criticisms leveled against the art of Murder and Mystery, 'in their classic literary forms, I should hasten to say' is the objection, whether philosophical or aesthetic, to the inevitable tidiness of the conclusion, toward which the form instinctively moves: whereby all that has been bewildering, and problematic, and, indeed, 'mysterious' is, off-times not altogether plausibly, resolved: which is to say, explained. It is objected that 'life is not like that' As if it were not, to all right-thinking persons, a triumphant matter that Evil be exposed in human form, and murderers, 'or murderesses' be brought to justice; and the fundamental coherence of the Universe confirmed. With that said, mysteries can be terribly entertaining. Where would literature be without Sherlock Holmes? Miller wrote a very entertaining mystery with Amish Old House Mysteries: the Evil Underneath. This book is aimed at the YA audience, but an adult would enjoy this book. I did. It's a rich story with it's main plot of who killed the couple, who used to live in the old house. Along with the main plot are the sub plots of the relationship between Hannah and her boyfriend. There's also the subplot of who frightened Hannah's sister and who is Mickey. All of these are interwoven mysteries are skillfully written by an experienced writer. The story at times will give you goosebumps but not nightmares just

enough of the fear factor. I wish Miller all the success in the world. Well done.
