

Growing up, I remember the I Can Read! series. I really like how Zondervan is releasing Christian versions of these. I particularly enjoyed A Father's Love. I really liked the illustrations. Even from the cover, I felt like this was going to be a good book. I think many kids will enjoy the illustrations. On the inside front cover, there is a spot to write the child's name. This may be in other books, but this is the first time I noticed it. I think this is really cool as it is not just a place to write the name of

the child the book belongs to, but I think it can be a cool incentive for them to learn to read the book. I think parents can let children write their name in the book, or the parent can do it after the child reads the book. This can act as a certificate.I think the story fit very close to the Bible. The thing to keep in mind is that this is a retelling, so it isn't 100% word for word what the Bible says, but is presented in a way kids will understand and get the biblical message.I would be happy to have this book in my collection for my child to have and I really like what Zondervan did with this book. I found the illustrations to be very well done and have a modern look and feel. ZonderKidz's Adventure Bible reading series is one of my favorite sets of children's books. Illustrated by David Miles, I have repeatedly been impressed with the full description of these Biblical stories. Though certainly toned down for children, the stories always are faithful to the Scriptures in their own subdued manner. In A Father's Love, Jesus Christ's parable of the prodigal son is told. A unique story to the gospel of Luke, the prodigal son is a story of being lost and found. Consistent to the Adventure Bible series, the conflict of the prodigal and the proud son is laid out in completion including the jealousy of the older brother. Though toned down, the full depravity of the younger son is put on display. The complete scope of the Biblical account is provided. Once again, parents concerned with the Scriptural integrity will be impressed with the ups and downs depicted in a children's book. As a reader's book, A Father's Love is of the second level with complete sentences and a fairly deep storyline. Our children did have a difficult time following the entire story for the first and second reading. Our oldest (3 years old) is

usually able to memorize entire books intended for her age but books at this levelÃ¢Â™s sentence structure is such memorization. In conclusion, A FatherÃ¢Â™s Love is a full depiction of the prodigal son. The illustrations are excellent and the story is true.
