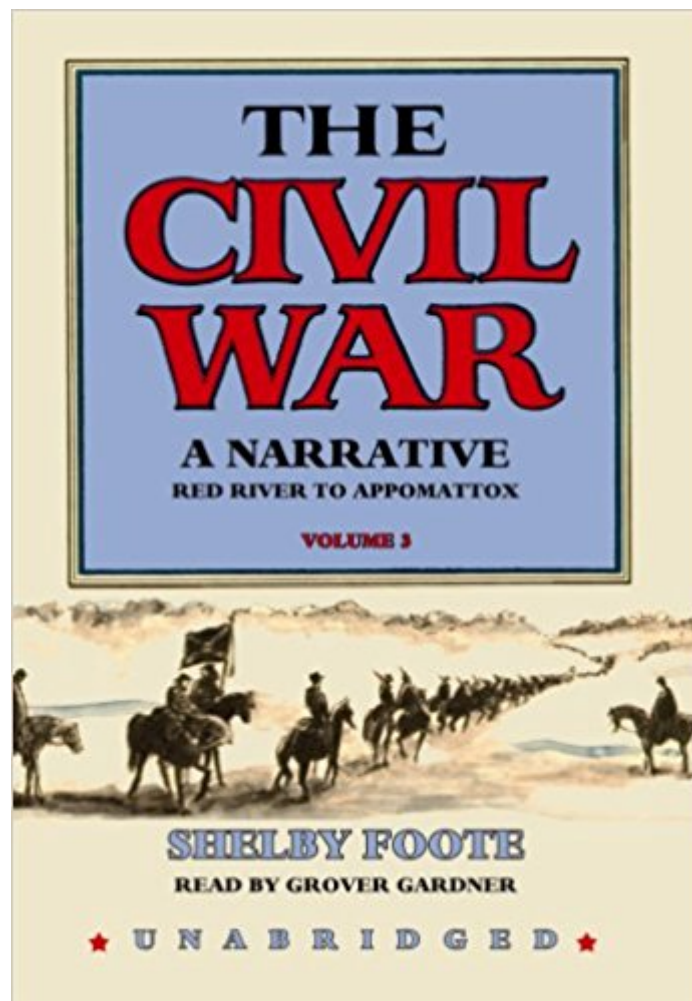




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The Civil War : A Narrative, Volume 3: Red River To Appomattox
