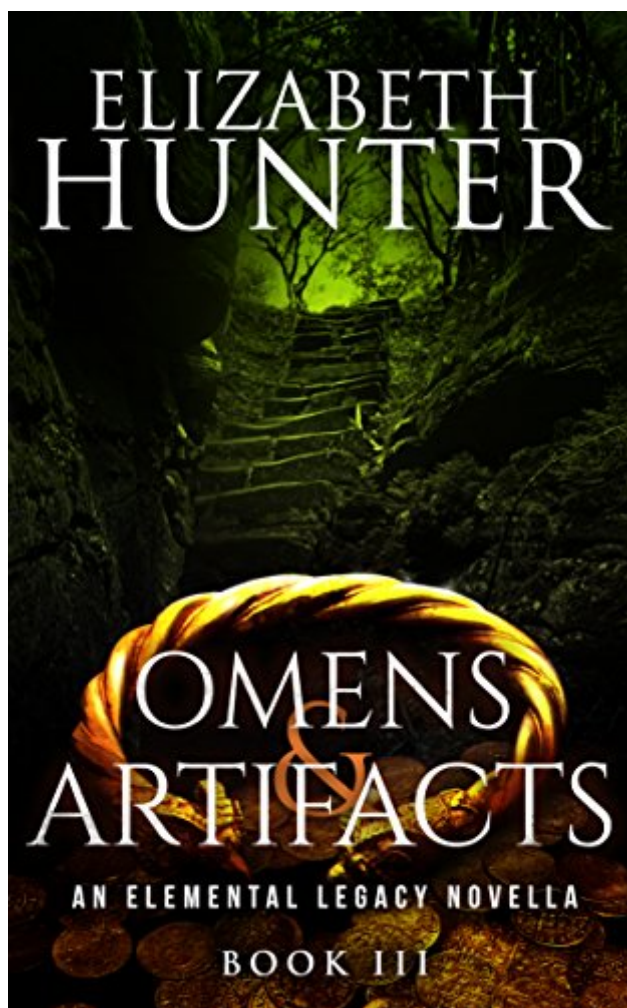

The real push behind this story is that Ben and Tenzin have set themselves up as antiques hunters but they have no clients, so the obvious solution, find something legendary that people have searched for centuries but never found to build a reputation for their new business. Enter the legendary sword of Brennus The Celt, King of Scotland, the Raven King and the actual search for lost sword of The Vampire King was highly entertaining and had a few twists that you were not expecting that were enjoyable. This novella is about the first "big find" for him, and he is bound and determined to be successful. But at what cost? The story went very quickly, with a lot of action, and a few surprises that I'm sure will have a bearing on later books. O&A left open a world of possibilities that are not answered. Will Ben stay human? Will he be forced to turn, or decide to turn? How powerful could he become? This is the beginning of Ben becoming a man. How will his manhood affect his relationship with Tenzin? Will it stay the same? Full of shenanigans, and bickering, but mutual respect and love. Or will it turn into another kind of relationship that we may not expect? I think that Tenzin would protect Ben at any cost, even if she had to turn him herself. After all, he is "her Ben." This novella is such a tease! And I loved it! I cannot wait for their journey.
