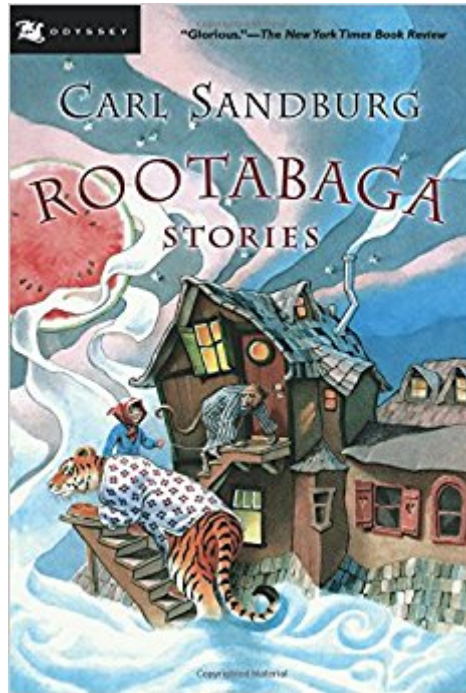

Wind Boy, corn fairies, blue foxes, and many more fanciful characters. Rootabaga Stories, Part One is irrepressible, zany Americana-an anthology to delight admirers of Sandburg's genius. --This text refers to an alternate Paperback edition.

Originally I was interested in the book because of it being a Carl Sandburg writing. After reading a chapter or so I lost interest. I felt the book tries too hard to be clever. I felt it was trying to appeal to children with overly descriptive character names and circumstances. I found it hard to follow myself, so perhaps younger readers would find it hard to follow also.

I first encountered these stories when my children were small. All of us responded with delight to the word music and rhythm of Sandburg's writing. The off-beat names for people and things and the imaginative/implausible events and explanations delighted them. Now we are using that sense of skewed reality to prompt the imagination of seniors. The stories are wonderful and timeless.

My son, who works on programming for English as a second language programs, loves this book and will use it in his work. The stories are so delightful. I wish I had heard of them much earlier. I would have read them to my children when they were little.
