

Dale Ralph Davis is minister in residence at First Presbyterian Church in Columbia, South Carolina, and formerly professor of Old Testament at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson. He now lives in rural Tennessee and is the author of many books, including an expository study of Judges and *The Word Became Fresh: How to Preach from Old Testament Narrative Texts*.

I'm in the midst of my study of Daniel and, as usual with Dale Davis' books, am enjoying the journey immensely. His "modernizing" of Biblical situations make me laugh out loud and make my study time extremely enjoyable. I learn an incredible amount from his writings and make constant notations in the margins of my Bible (so much so that I often run out of "white space".) His commentaries are some of the best out there as he delves into the historical and theological aspects of every subject he tackles. His commentaries are easy to read and understand and you'll find yourself thinking about what you've studied well into your day. Daniel is a difficult book to read and I haven't yet gotten to the revelations that he received so I look forward to Mr. Davis' insights into those and his continuing revelations on the great God we serve.
