

I started reading this book after my husband deployed to Afghanistan for a one year deployment. I had already read a few other military spouse books about what to expect when being a military spouse and other books where wives told stories about how they coped with the military lifestyle and their husband's deployments. Those books were okay, but not for me. Frankly, they just made me feel worse and they are full of sad stories. Don't get me wrong, I feel for these spouses, but those books do not make you feel good when your husband is in a combat zone. Then I ordered Mollie Gross's book and it was just what I needed. I found myself laughing out loud at many of the parts of the book. I especially enjoyed her stories about her grandma Ruby. This book is not a guide book. If you want a guide book and you need help finding a job, go to ACS... or read a guide book! Mollie states clearly that her book is not a guide book. This book is fun and is meant to make you laugh. She touches on some serious issues, but I think her purpose is to make military spouses feel good and find happiness during a deployment and when dealing with stressful things such as PCS moves. I could relate to her on so many levels and she gives good advice about dealing with families, coping with deployments, moving constantly, etc. Don't take it so seriously and have some

fun with the book! I can't wait for Mollie's next book to come out.

As a brand new Army wife, it was so refreshing to finally come across a book that was so honest. I am TIRED of getting books shoved under my nose about all the "proper decorum" I need to be brushing up on before my first time living on base. Mollie covers it all - moving, making friends... (maybe a few enemies), living on a budget, insurance (TRICARE aka they don't try & they don't care!) adjusting to having your spouse gone all the time (just in time to adjust to their return), dealing with extended family & in-laws, the harsh reality of coming to grips that your spouse may die, and of course - being sexually frustrated for YOUR freedom....but wait, there's hope in the form of Mollie Gross: Dildo Fairy! While keeping the tone of the book incredibly playful and fun, she also touches on the darker side of military life, such as depression, anxiety, and death, without making you want to cry your eyes out. I definitely laughed out loud many occasions reading the book (the IBS flag incident), and am thinking of forcing everyone I come in daily contact with to read it. I felt like I knew Miss Mollie personally, as well as her best friends and it was comforting to know there are some other sane, fun-loving, beer-drinking, non-Stepford military wives out there!

This book is fantastic- I highly recommend it to any woman whose loved one is in the armed forces! I've read it so many times, I've lost count- and yet each time I read it, it still makes me smile and laugh like it's the first time. It's not corny or cheesy, and it's not a boring military spouse instructional handbook, either- it's a clever, insightful, and hilarious window into this life that is the Military. I read it when I first started dating my fiance in the Marine Corps, and it was so nice to have a veteran wife's comedic and yet poignant take on what I was about to enter into. A "getting your feet wet" experience for me! I didn't know any other military significant others at the time, and it was comforting to get an insider's perspective on what my future held. And the best part is that over the years, I've encountered and/or seen many of the things Mollie described in her book. Hopefully one day I might meet Mollie during one of our cross-country moves :)

As the wife of an enlisted Army NCO, I was pretty skeptical that I would be able to relate to the book. In fact, I'm so opinionated about my "role" as a military spouse I was ready to be enraged by the typical "you need to abide by the rules" speech I've heard so many times. While I do not agree with all the stances that Mollie takes on certain issues, overall I am very pleased with this book. Ms. Gross takes the formal military attitude and turns it upside down with crude humor (which I totally appreciate) and a critical look at how ridiculous our experiences in the military can be, especially as

spouses. I could totally relate to what she said and appreciated the advice that she gave in between belly laughs. This book made me laugh, out loud, many times and has helped me remember to be who I am, no matter who or what I am married to. THis book is amazing and you should read it, spouse or not!
