

Fans of Kathleen Brooks' Bluegrass (all three) and Women of Power series are in for a treat with this book that starts a new series. It's not the typical Brooks that fans have come to love. It's darker, more complex, and the story is not tied up in a nice neat bow at the end (it's not a cliffhanger, per se, but there are a lot of loose threads left hanging).

Brooks' previous books have been filled with suspense, romance, and humor, with a heavy emphasis on the latter two. She's created communities where the family is pivotal, the romance is a given, the humor is infectious, and the suspense is merely the seasoning. And if that's all you want, then maybe this isn't the book for you. But if you like your characters layered, your danger existential, and story complex, "Whispered Lies" will fill the bill. Yes, there's romance, but it's not the reason for the story, nor is there the typical happily ever after for the heroine and hero, but there is a "happy for now." At 253 pages, there isn't quite the depth to the plot or characters that I would like and I hope that as she continues to build this series the books become longer. Ms. Brooks' writing style is snappy so the story never dragged. My biggest quibble with the book is the intimation that DC and Quantico are but a few minutes apart by car. It's a minimum of 45 minutes without traffic and there is always traffic. Apart from that, she gets the feel for the town of Quantico (as opposed to the Marine Corps base that surrounds it) nicely. This is a good start to the series and I'm looking forward to seeing where she takes us next.

I have read every book Ms. Brooks has written, and never been disappointed, and this book is no different. A little darker than some of her books, but so engrossing. A secret group answerable only to the president is formed to take on internal terrorists that want to take over America and the rest of the world. Her characters and plot are top notch, and I look forward to reading more of this series, and getting to know and understand the characters better. I would give it ten stars if I could.

This book has been sitting on my Kindle for awhile and I just hadn't got around to reading it, mostly because I knew that it was part of a series and would probably end in a cliffhanger. I was right. I

can't wait for the next book to come out. Kathleen Brooks is a phenomenal writer. She takes characters and makes them real. Some parts were a little fast for me and I had to reread to catch up (probably my fault for not paying as much attention as I should) but overall it was a great first book.
