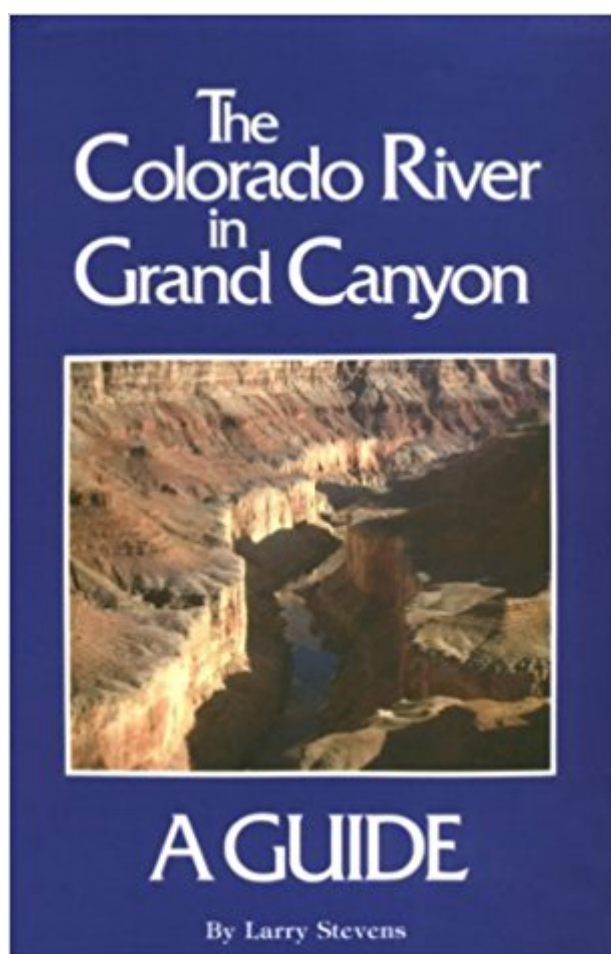

as mentioned, this guidebook is way out of date. mr. stevens is apparently no longer interested in updating it. in 1998 this was the guide to have - and at that time it did its job well. for a commercial passenger, the new belknap guide is the way to go. for a do-it yourself-er, get the most recent martin/whitis 'guide to the colorado river in the grand canyon'.

This is THE book to have for anyone taking a private river trip through the Grand Canyon. It's the only guide book that shows all of the camp sites and their relative size. It also rates the difficulty of all of the rapids. There should be one on every raft. For those quiet moments in camp the book contains a lot of information about the history and geology of the Grand Canyon as well as a lot of other information.
