

What a fun Light Novel format novel. The Genres are: comedy, slice of life, harem (one male protagonist, a lot of females attracted to the male), romance. Don't worry, there is no lewdness in this story. In fact, it's quite free of most inappropriate imagery. I can't say ALL because I have no idea what everyone considers inappropriate. The main protagonist is a human priest that suffers from THE WORST case of luck in the galaxy. If there is the most minuscule chance something is going to go wrong, it will go wrong around the protagonist. The main protagonist is physically weak, but has a soul of gold and an iron will. The romantic comedy develops as the female aliens slowly appreciate his kindness, forthrightness, and his strength of character. All the ladies around him could turn him into confetti. More interesting, each girl is a representation for an extreme type of culture or a social problem. The author uses character interactions to deliver critique on social mores from both sides (for and against) issues: corruption in the government, corruption in non-profit organizations, social perceptions and education. It is QUITE a fun read. Read the book if you're interested in Light Novels and the genres involved. It's fun, hilarious, and easy to enjoy. The book DOES have spelling errors, pacing issues, and editing mistakes, but it's still quite fun. It felt restful. :-)

A light novel about a man who is reincarnated. In his past life he was the most hated and feared man in the universe. A destroyer of worlds and countless lives. This man is then reincarnated as the war he waged on the universe and all life ends. Now he is reborn to regain his memories and terrorize the universe anew. Or not instead he has such bad Karma and luck he destroys all electronics near him and often causes himself harm. Oh and did I mention he is a monk. Now well how about the women who love him. A demon who eats souls. Heiress of the richest and most powerful mafia family in the galaxy. A wolf huntress and for good measure a shapeshifting slime creature childhood friend oh and a pirate general.

As a subgenre, 'monster girl' fiction is largely unrepresented and those that do venture into it as

authors are at best lackluster, repeating tropes with shallow characters. Not so with this author and 'Kharmic Rebound'. Yes, all the pieces are here, the herbivore MC, the bevy of monster girl archetypes, but with a delightfully new spin put on them all, and with depth of personality that fleshes them out instead of being two dimensional cutouts. This is a -long- novel, and yet its pacing and twists and turns never let any portion of it 'drag on' as a reader. I am almost relieved that there was such closure at its end, as sequel novels rarely match the original and the original cleared a high bar indeed.

This isn't the first anime inspired tale I've read and usually I find myself cringing more than a bit, and I did here. The hero could have been pulled from just about any harem anime that has come out in the last 10-15 years. He's useless 99.9999% of the time, but has beautiful and talented women falling for him when they should hate it. (and many of them keep pointing that out.) Yet, despite that, I found this book a fun read. Yes, the main character is not a hero in many ways, but the tale is one of overcoming that, and the harem is diverse and energetic enough to push this light-hearted tale. I wouldn't recommend this to anyone who expects a deep ponderous book although it is long and can drag a bit. However, it captured much of the whimsy and wonder that makes good harem anime into something that can be fun to watch (in small quantities.). I hope Aaron moves on to other plot twists in the future, but this is a fun book to read once.

For me a good book is one that refuses to let you put it down at any given point. I started reading this yesterday at 10pm local time, kept reading until I finally passed out of exhaustion at 9am today. Just finished it and the clock is 10pm. So within 24 hours I've consumed this book and it was totally worth it. The story isn't perfect mind, but it is a pretty cracking read. Very heavily influenced by Japanese harem manga/light novel themes but without the typical frustrations that come with them. Since Yeager actually wrote a male protagonist with more than two braincells to rub together and an actual (thank the heavens) backbone. Plenty of tragedy and tears but it makes the final outcome all the more delicious in its happiness. Will definitely be looking at this author's other works.

I got this book for free at an Anime convention in my home State of Utah. I probably wouldn't have gotten it otherwise. I also really like Harem Anime because it's a very imaginative, funny, lighthearted and heartwarming genre. There are some parts of this book that I really like and that I think are literary genius and other parts that are dumber than hell. The pop culture references in particular I thought were unnecessary and kind of silly. The characters especially were hit or miss. I

really liked the Pink Blob Girl and the Green Rich Girl; they were my favorite characters and they were very likable and hilarious characters to read about. I really didn't like the wolf girl and the main character in particular was really likable in some parts of the story and extremely annoying and infuriating in other parts. Overall I really liked the book although there were some bumps in the road.
