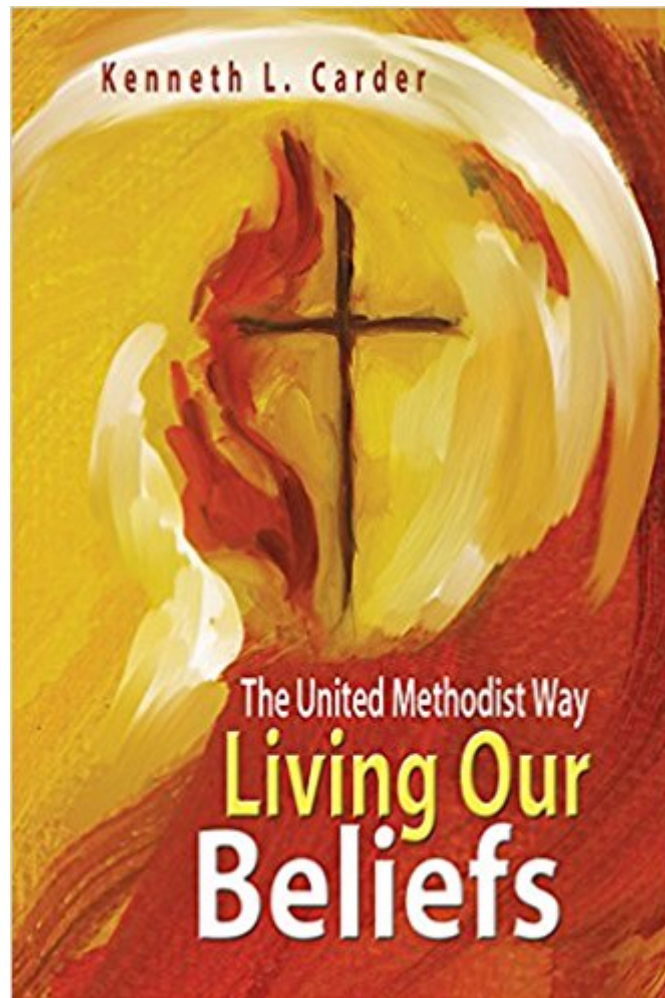




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Living Our Beliefs: The United Methodist Way

Carder's 2009 book about Methodist beliefs is engaging and useful.
