

in 2009 I wrote a letter to Huston Smith telling him that in my teens I had taken a course on world religions at Boston University and the professor had used as textbook Smithâ¢Â™s â¢ÂœThe Religions of Manâ¢Ââ• (now titled â¢ÂœThe Worldâ¢Â™s Religionsâ¢Ââ•). I told Smith that I had recently become an adjunct professor of world religions at FSU and that after examining a dozen textbooks I could not find one that came even close to the beauty and understanding Smith conveys in clear and eloquent prose in â¢ÂœThe Worldâ¢Â™s Religions.â¢Ââ• Therefore, I

chose to use his book as the textbook for all my comparative religion classes. Smith wrote back that my letter had arrived on his 90th birthday and he said, "I couldn't have asked for a better birthday present!"

This is not a reference book. It covers the basic beliefs of various religions and is written lovingly. The author has obvious respect for all he writes about. Very enjoyable treatise on the world's religions. I highly recommend it.
