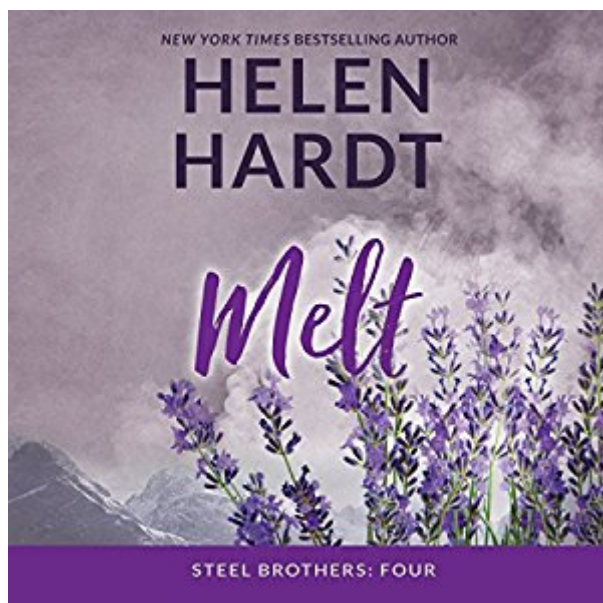


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Melt: The Steel Brothers Saga, Book 4

This is the fourth book in the Steel brothers series. After reading about Talon and Jade, I wondered what would come next. Melt continues to show how what had happened to Talon shaped Jonah's future as well. Jonah, still struggling with what happened years ago decides to seek help. Meeting Dr. Melanie Carmichael as a patient causes him to start facing his inner demons but she has to face some of her own. It is evident from the first meeting they are drawn towards each other. Is the passion they share together ever going to be enough to overcome their own personal demons? The love scenes in this book will make you melt. The book is fast paced and filled with emotion. You will not want to put it down until you have finished. Helen Hardt has again written an outstanding novel. I look forward to reading more.

While I've read books 1 through 4, I didn't decide to write a review until completing number 4. The

books are well written, characters are developed nicely and the story line is interesting although disturbing. I read all 4 in about 3 days. Which brings me to my next point...I think I am tired of books with cliffhangers forcing me to pay and pay and pay. These four books could easily have been two very excellent book including what is obviously coming in book number five. This is the first time I've read books from this author and I must say she writes well enough to make you feel a part of the story but I'm probably won't be reading any others. ****SPOILERS AHEAD****OMG!! So I wasn't sure how I would feel about this book since it was about two new characters, Jonah and Melanie, and not about Talon and Jade. I loved Talon and Jade from the first three books but Jonah had always peaked my interest. You see at the beginning of this book that Jonah has so much guilt about not being able to help Talon twenty-five years ago when he was abducted. Talon finally convinces Jonah to go talk to Dr. Carmichael, Melanie. Jonah and Melanie had an instant attraction when they met months before but Melanie felt that as his doctor it was inappropriate to act on those feelings. Jonah isn't the only one dealing with personal issues. Melanie had a patient commit suicide months before and it affected her confidence in her ability to do her job. After going back and forth, Jonah and Melanie finally hook up. This happens multiple times but you come to realize that both of them are using sex to escape the present and their problems. There's so many different parts to this story. Along with Jonah and Melanie trying to figure out the relationship that they are going to have, you have Jonah and his brothers, Ryan and Talon, trying to figure out the secrets of what happened to Talon all those years ago. You also have Melanie trying to figure out where she went wrong with her past patient who committed suicide. I

don't want to ruin the ending but all I have to say is February cannot come soon enough."No wonder I was drawn here. To you. Because you're the one person who might just understand."

This is the oldest brothers story - Jonah. It is a continuation of the first 3 books (Talon's story) and by the end of book 6 the mystery of what happened to Talon is still not solved. Jonah's series is a bit more exciting than Talon's. Much more happens. Again with Jonah's story, the author drags out the story in 3 books which really only amounts to 1 book but the author makes more money this way by leaving cliff hangers so you have to buy another book. Very uncool. Jonah is much more likeable than Talon but his lady love - Melanie - is completely unlikeable. Again like Talon's story, the characters latch on to an idea obsessively and just keep repeating it throughout the story until you are just annoyed. Melanie's angst is a bit far fetched. She's a complete bore. Jonah's character needed a much more interesting lady love. While Jonah is likeable, his obsession over not being there for Talon is a bit unrealistic & begins to get annoying but I guess he has to have some baggage because all of these characters have to have some serious flaw. I can see how the story is progressing - 1 part of the mystery of what happened to Talon is solved by the end of each brothers story so I guess one more part will be solved by the end of the youngest brothers story and then there is the sister. The author seemed to be setting up the sisters story by the end of the 6th book so readers be prepared to read many more books before the mystery that starts with the first book is finally solved. I'll finish out this Steel brother series but I won't be reading any more of this author's books for being so annoying about dragging this story out!

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
