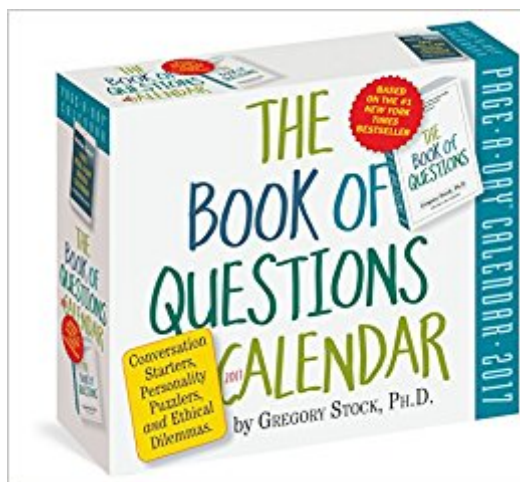

The *Book of Questions: Revised and Updated* by Gregory Stock is exactly what I expected and meets my needs perfectly! As a women's Ministry Director, I often create icebreaker questions for small groups. This book has some awesome ideas for building relationships, sharing and connecting hearts. It would also be useful for blogging topics, or dinner conversations with family and friends. Here are some sample questions:

This is one way to get to know someone with out feeling like you are asking 100 questions. I had the original book many years ago and saw this new revised edition and I really like that its up to date. Great way to kill time while on a long road trip. Good book for pillow talk.

I'm a bit disappointed with this book. Many of the questions are 2 paragraphs long which I found annoying and there seem to be a lot of sexual questions as well. Very few one lined questions. I was looking for PG to PG-13 and this one is definitely rated R. Not comfortable playing this with people I'm just meeting and trying to get to know.

This gets conversation going if nothing else! We're starting a church and need to get to know some of the other people...this offers one way to do that. Some of the questions are a little too serious but others are just plain funny!!The more serious questions we save for meetings that call for seriousness. The others we use for some absolute uninhibited laughter! I'm hoping my family will be up for some random questions at our next get together.

This book is a decent book--- for what it is for. My point in buying this was to take it to some friends' houses and use it as a conversation starter/ enhancer.Many of the questions are quite asinine, but there are enough gems to be found in order for the book to serve its purpose.Verdict:
