

The battle protocols for space battles are oddly constraining and similar to the British army marching formations during conflicts during the 1700's. Somewhat slow - the #3 book hopefully includes more combat.

The second book in the series is far better than the first, but the action still needs improvement. At the end, things were looking great, but the story ended.
