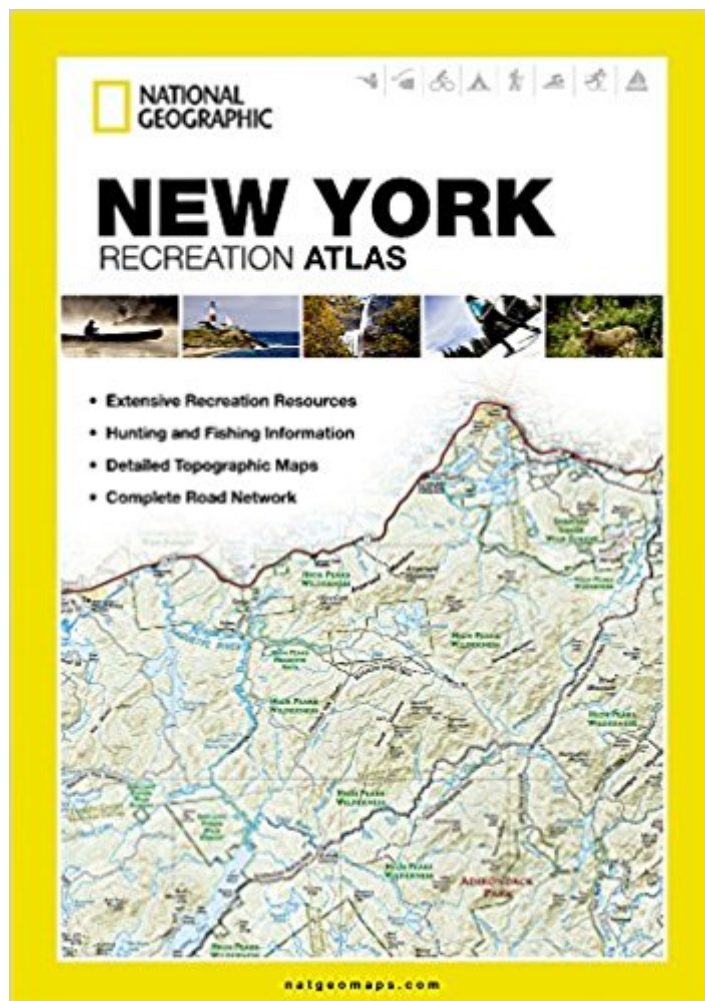

Forget about trolling the internet for vacation/short trip options. This atlas gives you more. There are sections devoted to particular activities (hiking, canoeing etc,) but the best part is that the maps are detailed enough to show many, many features in a particular locale. With this atlas you will be better prepared to take on the unknown and make mid course corrections to a trip if necessary. A great gift for an outdoorsy type.

I recently picked up this atlas when planning a trip on the Northern Forest Canoe Trail. If you're not familiar with that canoeing and kayaking trail, which winds its way through many New York lakes, it runs from Old Forge up to the north east, leaving New York at Lake Champlain. There are dedicated maps for the Northern Forest Canoe Trail, but the problem is that they cost about \$12 each! That struck me as a total rip off, so I bought this atlas instead. For my trip, I simply tore out the pages that I needed, five in all, and took them along in the boats (sealed in multiple ZipLoc bags). As for the quality of the maps, I was impressed. They charted all the lakes and small roads that we took on our 60+ mile trip. The details were very useful to us, including camp grounds, various types of parks, and details about the towns along the way. This is a nice map for anyone looking to get outdoors, but it's also a decent road map! I could imagine using this to navigate the roads and highways as well as the backroads and lakes. Note that this is not a set of detailed topographic maps, so if you're

an orienteer or backpacker, you might be looking for a higher level of detail. However, for everyone else interested in exploring New York State, I think you'll like this set of maps.

I am a canoe and kayak paddler and have long been dependent on Delorme Atlas and Gazetteers. I find the new National Geographic Recreation Atlas far superior for my use. I think that they are much easier to read. They also have boat ramps and camping facilities labeled. I am currently updating my atlas library with the National Geographic atlases as a new one comes out. I highly recommend them for use by people who enjoy the outdoor and being off the main roads.

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
