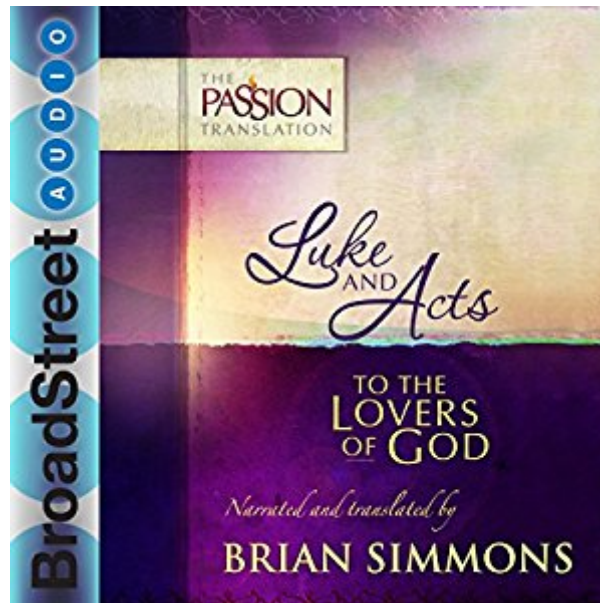

Wow! I was raised as a King James only girl, and I'm just now starting to really meditate on God's Word, and research words in Greek and Aramaic (the Hebrew dialect that Jesus spoke in). I read

the Amplified Bible a few months ago, and it is amazing how in detail the verses go to try to include full definitions of what Jesus says and what it written through others by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. I love it. After that, I thought I would cautiously compare the Greek and Aramaic meanings to the Passion Translation. Wow. I am finding that the words that are in the King James Version need to be researched more thoroughly in order to understand them in their original context that the Bible was originally written in. The Amplified version is such a big help as it includes so many Greek and Hebrew definitions within brackets in the verses themselves. I feel that the Passion translation has found a way to include the Greek and Aramaic definitions in a way that enhances the narration of these beautiful and powerful stories of God's Word, rather than break it up. I am absolutely in love with it, and I feel like it really portrays the powerful and romantic love letter to us all from the Creator of the Universe in the best way I've read so far! May we all learn to receive everything He has given us through this glorious book.
