

Although this was a very short book, I thought it was interesting. It presents a different perspective on the validity of reports about H.H. Holmes. The author presents a skeptical viewpoint that was a nice way to balance the content from The Devil in the White City, which is a book I love. He provides

a tour of the foundation and basement where the castle stood. The castle burned in a fire, so it isn't a tour of the building, just the basement and foundation around the current-standing post office. At the same time, he talks about an encounter he had that's rather spooky. He provides a link to the recording as well to back up the report. The only negative is the length of the book. It is short. The last portion of the book is a preview of another book he wrote. It's a long preview, so it looks as though they included it to add more pages. However, I'm glad I purchased it.

Holmes was the consummate sociopath and does not appear to have had an ounce of humanity. If you like things that go bump in the night with an historical bent, you'll like this. Some may be put off by the writer's casual style but I enjoyed it. If you have read "The Devil in the White City," this is a good follow up. The author has a good attitude toward the paranormal.
