

The book itself is really nice, as far as the art quality goes, but the actual physical quality of the book is awful. The spine of the book, the way the pages are placed in the hardcover, is so bad, that as soon as the book was opened, the pages ripped off at the base. Some of the pages are almost completely coming out, and i have only opened it once. I will try and see if i can either get another book, or trade out the one i have. Until then, the review is as stands.

This is a nice artbook, but as others have commented, the binding is a little suspect. It's not terrible,

so I only docked it half a star (which, unfortunately, became a whole one), as none of the pages are falling out or anything. But the binding is visible when the book is open, and I tend to read it kind of half-open, so as not to stress the binding further. That isn't an ideal way to read, especially for a book this large. However, the page stock is good and thick, and doesn't seem flimsy. The contents are interesting--I especially like Ikumi Nakamura's whimsical commentary. Some of the renders are contained in the game itself as an extra, but there are many interesting concepts that never made it into the game. There is also slightly more background information on the characters, which probably should have been covered in the game itself! If you're a big fan of the game, this is a great book, but it probably won't stand up to aggressive handling (and really, why would you need to do so?).

The book is amazing, love all of the different costumes for each of the character especially for Kimball and The Keeper. I would gladly give this book a 5/5 however, I noticed one significant problem with my book, I have around 20 extra pages that are the exactly same as the previous 20 pages or so in my book. So I'm not sure if I lost some artwork or I have extra 20 pages. That kind of bugged me because the book itself is amazing with all of the cool artwork in different mediums etc. If I could get a new book that is 100% correct, I would gladly give this book 5 out of 5!

The art of *The Evil Within* inside is great. Personally, I love the hell out of this game and am dying for a sequel. However, the physical book itself has a problem with the spine. It just seems flimsy or loose, like the pages will fall out at any given moment. In fact, if you look closely you can see that the pages aren't intact very well to the hardcover of the book at all. I would return this artbook for a new copy but I really don't want to go through the hassle of returning it, and nonetheless for a book that's of the same quality, as other reviews seem to say the same thing about the poorness of the spine. If it weren't for this issue, I would've given this artbook five stars.

The game is highly enjoyable and the artbook itself is top quality, Dark horse books seems to nail all the right things when it comes to their artbooks. The artbook is full of information about the characters and the art is just incredible, The lead concept artist Ikumi Nakamura is a very talented individual, I personally don't like the Japanese art at all, but this is just pure beauty. I would recommend this to anyone who enjoyed *The Evil Within*, it's a must have !

Character arts and environment arts are superb. I especially loved the undead arts. Every page is nicely filled with art. However the binding of the pages seemed as if it is going to fall off easily. The

binds are visible as well unlike other art books that I owned. Would have given a 5/5 if the binding is good.

I was really looking forward to this book of the art and stories involved in the making of the new video game, Art of Evil Within. This would make an excellent movie and hopefully someone in Hollywood will take notice.
