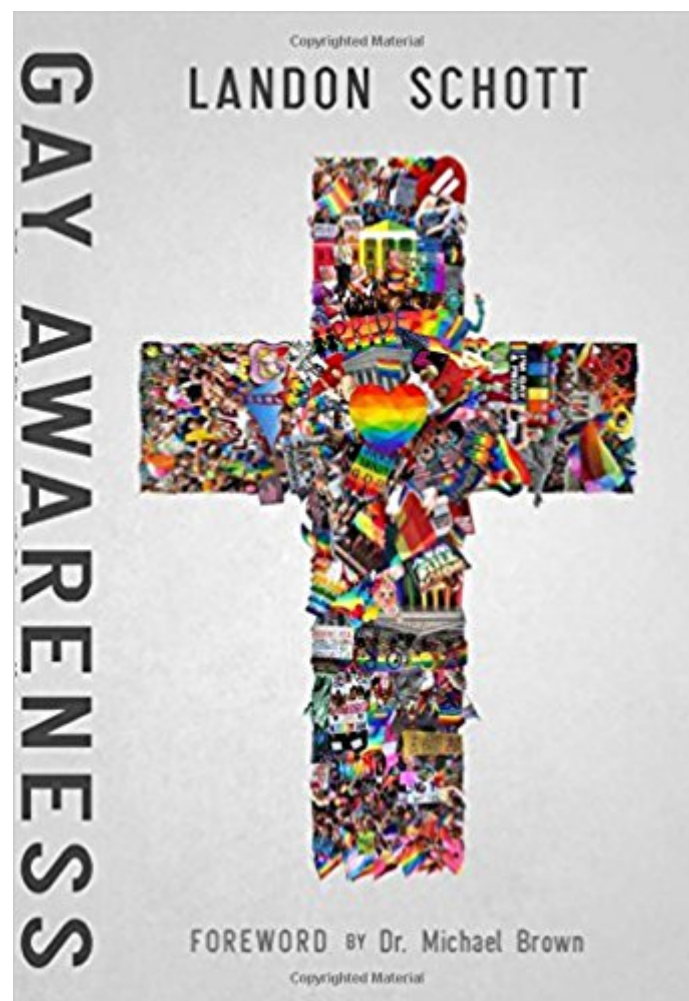

I took my time to read Rev. Landon Schott's book. After reaching its end, I feel I have to read it again. So I will re-read it before I post a full review. What I can share immediately however, is that this book ministers to all of us, not just to people with same-sex attraction. Its scope is much, much broader than the topic of homosexuality because the implications of the scriptures quoted (400 different verses, that's a lot!) extend to all aspects of our Christian lives and force us to have a good look at who we are and what we do to follow Jesus. A second reading will enable me to increase my understanding and let the Holy Spirit work even deeper. I give this book a 5-star on first reading, however: it has fired up a vital spiritual process that really needed to be ignited.
