

If you like natural history illustrations, here are some wonderful images nicely reproduced. The radiolarians are my favorite and Haeckel did a superb job delineating them as well as jellyfish and siphonophores. These images are slightly different in form and function compared to Haeckel's masterpiece *Art Forms in Nature*. Here the plates are earlier works and more purely representational while in *Art Forms*...where the images are arranged in a more sophisticated way and a little more stylized. If you like Haeckel you will have fun with this book.
