

Hofsommer records the end of branchline passenger service, the demise of electric railroads, the transition from steam to diesel power, as well as the end of common carrier freight service on the Colorado narrow gauge. Off the Main Lines carries readers along out-of-the-way railways in Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Colorado, Oklahoma, Texas, Montana, and South Dakota to see the changes that occurred on these lines from the 1940s to the 1990s.

Donovan L. Hofsommer is Professor of History at St. Cloud State University and president of the Lexington Group. He is author of *Steel Trails of Hawkeyeland* (IUP, 2005) and (with H. Roger Grant) of *Iowa's Railroads: An Album* (IUP, 2009).

Well written and covers the transition of railroads, specifically in Iowa, from steam to diesel, through mergers and abandonment. The photographs are not the usual mainline action, but are almost nostalgic, bringing back memories of railroading in the late 1950s forward.

I like the pictures. The text is informative too. Good material here for those who like to model short lines.

I rated it a four, rather than a five, as a few of the captions are so light of a typeface they get lost in the photograph. This should have been caught before the book went to press. You get a lot of photos for your money even with this being a softcover book. Most of the photographic coverage is the upper midwest and Colorado narrow gauge. Photos are very well reproduced.

I chose to order the book because I have met Don Hofsommer and sat through an amazing slide and movie show of his several years ago. I recall stating that he should publish his works. This is not his movies, but since his childhood in Iowa less than forty miles from my home, I jumped at the chance to buy the book. Much of it is Iowa. Not all, but much. Regardless, the side notes and great images make the price worth the purchase.
