

I just took the NCLEX (June 2017) and passed in 75 questions. This book is very helpful in preparing for NCLEX but was supplemental for me personally in my preparation. The BEST way to prepare for the NCLEX is to study hard in nursing school and do a lot of NCLEX questions throughout nursing school rather than trying to cram at the last minute. In that light, it is better to purchase a book like this during your first semester in nursing school and to use it regularly. This book is colorful, well-written and has tons of questions. There are plenty of alternative style questions (SATA, hotspot, ordered response). I also used the Hurst program (my school required us to attend it) and UWorld (an online question bank with fantastic rationales). To be honest, this book has similar style questions and costs a lot less. (Hurst is \$200+ for live class and online resources; UWorld was \$79 for a month of online access.) No one individual learning aid helped me to pass. It

was the combination of thousands of hours of studying and doing thousands of NCLEX practice questions over the 2 years of school.

I purchased this book because I'm taking the NCLEX exam at the end of May...it has WAY more questions than any other NCLEX review book I saw. There are tons of SATA questions, which is what I'm most nervous for so that was really helpful. On top of that, the rationales are really comprehensive and help you understand the question, and not just memorize the answer. There's a code in the book where you can take Q&A online and by taking a few quizzes, I was able to see which areas I needed to focus my studying on. Overall, I love that this is a print book with questions online as well - I really feel like I got my moneys worth and that this is preparing me well for the exam. Fingers crossed!

The NCLEX-RN does not simply test entry-level knowledge and understanding of important nursing concepts, but intentionally concentrates on questions that test higher levels of cognitive ability such as analysis, evaluation, and synthesis. This review guide takes a methodical approach to understanding and preparing for the complexities of the exam. Don't skip the preface, as it explains how to use the review guide. Then three short chapters cover the structure of the test, the structure of the questions, covers general test-taking tips, and provides information specific to international and repeat test-takers. Appended are a full bibliography of the content sources and a reasonably good index. The majority of the book provides 2,750 review questions organized in chapters by content so that areas of strengths and weaknesses can be identified, plus two comprehensive exams. In addition, there is a bank of 10,000 additional questions available online (using the included code) to create practice tests for areas that need additional attention as well as comprehensive exams that simulate the full NCLEX. Familiarity with the subject matter is critical, but it is equally important to understand how to approach each question to provide the correct answer, especially with the alternate format questions. The answers at the end of each test chapter are evidence-based and have references provided, along with rationales for all of the correct and the incorrect choices for full understanding. Each answer is then followed by helpful information such as definitions, guidelines, how to work through the particular question format, and similar tips. Content area, concept, integrated processes, client needs, and cognitive level are also identified. This additional material provides a real advantage when preparing for the increased complexities of the current NCLEX. It would be very helpful to begin using this guide sooner rather than later as understanding the NCLEX structure and design will help with organizing and understanding course

content and successfully taking exams while in school as well as with passing the NCLEX after graduation.

The questions are challenging, they have a ton of select all that apply, which I was terrible at but this really helped me get used to them and gave me tips on how to work through those harder questions. This is a huge, heavy Q & A review book! It boasts 12,750 practice questions, which they claim is more than any other review book. The inside cover has a scratch off that reveals an access code for a free one year subscription to their online q&a with over 10,000 questions. It includes alternate format questions, rationales for all answer options, test taking tips and a comprehensive exam builder. The book has an introduction to the NCLEX exam, test taking strategies to manage time, reduce stress and prepare for alternate-format questions. 2,750 of the questions are in the book (with answers, rationales and test taking tips), while the rest of the 10,000+ questions are online. The online portion helps identify weak areas and has an exam builder that generates simulated MCLEX exams. Inside the book the practice tests are separated by units: management of care; fundamentals of nursing; care of childbearing families; care of adults; care of children and families; care of individuals with mental health disorders. It includes comprehensive exams 1 & 2. There is an appendix and bibliography. Each question/answer has a test taking tip, which I think is great. This is a very thorough book that is a great asset for helping you to prepare to take your exam!

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
