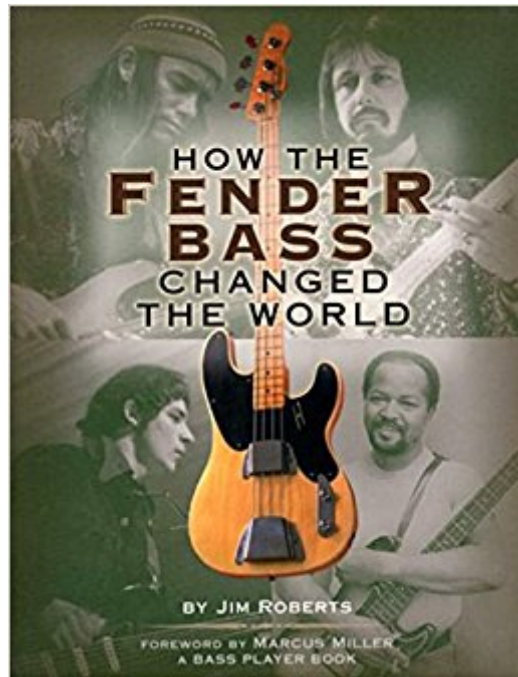

A lot of good subjective and fairly objective insight presented by many famous bass players. Author, Jim Roberts, places the Fender bass in proper historical context. Contains valuable research. A welcome addition to my Fender library.

Being a bass player for over forty years, it was wonderful to look back at the instrument's evolution from a 1950's curiosity to an indispensable element in most of today's music. I started my playing with a Fender (1968 Jazz) and now I have a 2008 P-bass with a lot of other brands in between, but all along, the industry standard has been the Fender bass. This book chronicles the Fender bass' 57 years of history along with most of the major players (Fender or not) in a manner not seen in any other publication. I highly recommend it to anyone who plays or is interested in the bass guitar.
