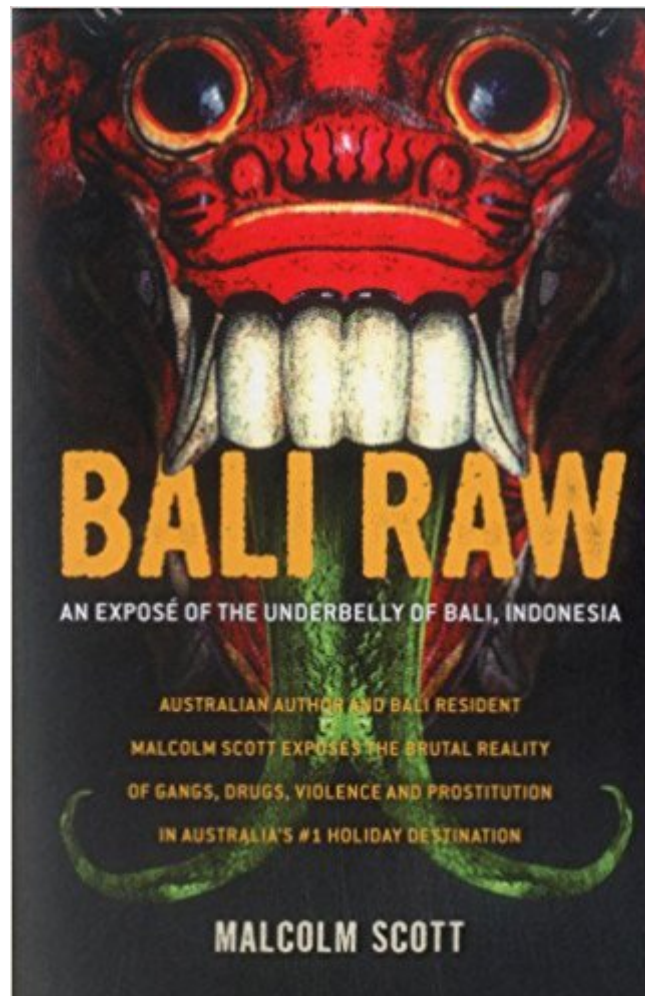




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# Bali Raw: An Expos  Of The Underbelly Of Bali, Indonesia
