

Michio Hoshino -- born in Japan in 1952 -- graduated from Keio University, Department of Economics in 1975. Since 1978 he has been taking photographs of Alaskan wildlife. His work has appeared in major publications in Japan and in the United States, including *Anima*, a Japanese natural history magazine, *Smithsonian*, *Audubon*, and *National Geographic*. In 1986 his first book, *Grizzly* won the annual *Anima* Award, the prize given to the the most distinguished wildlife photography. --This text refers to an out of print or unavailable edition of this title.

I had an unusual connection with Hoshino. Visiting Alaska and BC in 1996 (on our honeymoon), while in Barrow I read on a photocopied news headline sheet that he had recently been killed by

bears while on a shoot. Travelling south we wound up in the Queen Charlotte Islands and staying at a floating base camp for a few days I saw one of his books on the shelf. I recognized the name and told our hosts the news. They were shocked--they had taken him out on private tours of the islands a few times and knew him very well. I ordered this book soon afterwards. Hoshino was obviously a very patient photographer and possibly a bit too drawn to the bears. His talent is obvious.
