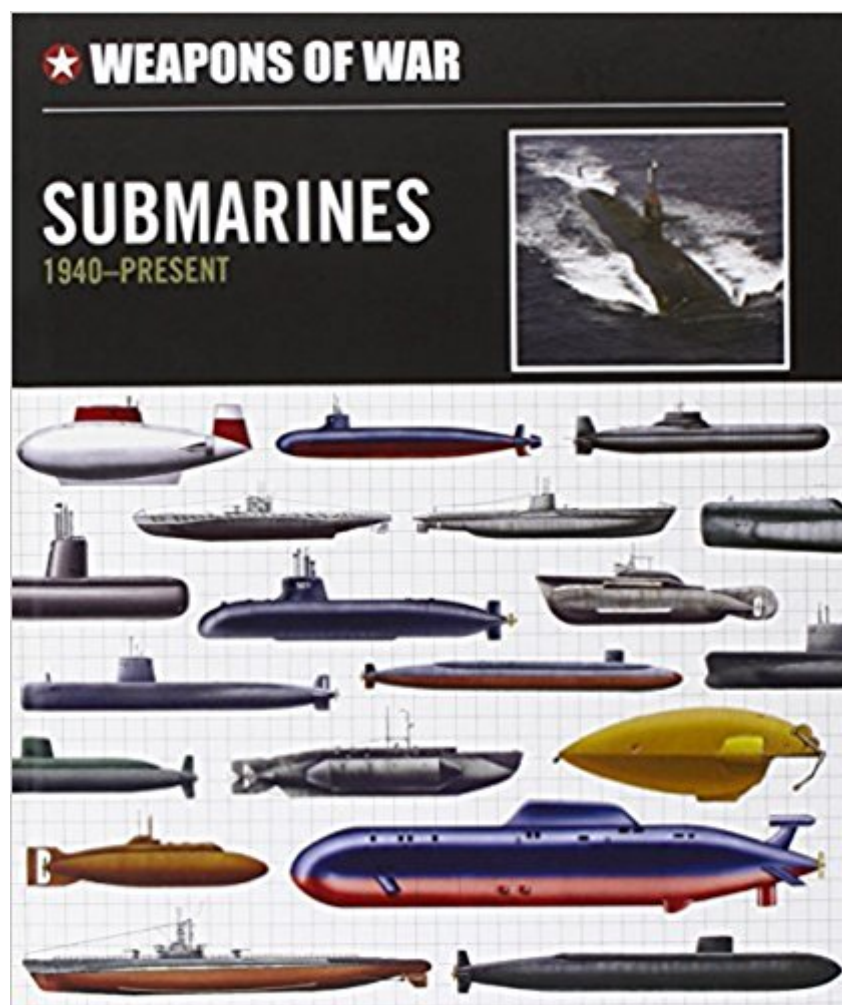


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Weapons Of War Submarines 1940-Present

Although this says it is published in 2013, there is evidence that it was actually written in the early 2000s. Many of the references cite things "scheduled in 2003", etc indicating that it is merely an updated version. There is a section of the book where the names of the submarines are flipped - the names actually belong to the sub on the opposing page - happens on about 8 consecutive pages. Overall, it is a nice set of photos and information, but they should not put this out as a modern 2013 book.

I read a lot of techno thrillers such as Tom Clancy and Stephen Coonts and having a book like this in my hands and not having to run to the internet to look up and learn about the different submarines and underwater naval vehicles makes this book well worth its money. I enjoy having a reference book in my hands where if I need to look something up, it takes only a few minutes instead of having to constantly scroll through pages and pages of websites. This book is well worth its price.

If this is your kind of thing (you know who you are), this is a book you're going to like. It is a comprehensive encyclopedia of submarine boats and their respective armaments. The coverage is excellent, and includes every military boat from all the major navies worldwide, since 1940. Each entry includes an nice color plate, a general specification, and a short essay detailing the history of the design. There is a good introductory chapter about the history of submarine technology. All this fits in a neat, compact book that fits easily in one hand. The only real gripe I have is minor: I wish the color plates were drawn to the same scale so we could get an idea of each boat's relative size. Otherwise, this book is exactly what I wanted, for less than ten bucks. Can't beat that.

The subject matter was great but the book is soooooo small. I should have paid closer attention to the dimensions in the product description. It seems most of the books like this one are getting smaller and smaller.
