

Unfortunately many vendors and 'authorities' on bonsai still hark back to the old days and continue to perpetuate myths and bad practises. Upon finding that I work as a professional bonsai artist, many people will remark that they once had a bonsai, but it died and with some regret, they gave up. It is hoped that this book, 'Bonsai4me: Bonsai Basics', will arm those new to bonsai with a solid foundation of knowledge that will enable them to successfully keep their bonsai alive and well, through very simple practises, and continue to enjoy, what for many that practise the Art, is a life-long passion. Bonsai4me: Bonsai Basics takes the reader through the basics of caring for their first bonsai with honest, simple and straightforward advice from the writer of Bonsai4me, Harry Harrington. Great resource for those seeking introductory information regarding the art of Bonsai such as myself. The book covers many areas from tools, soils, styling, fertilizing, etc. Its photography shows what beautiful natural sculptures these trees really are.

If someone, like myself, is new to bonsai, this might be a good place to start. Often beginners in a hobby struggle with jargon and other technical concepts, but I found that this book took a "dummies" approach to it. I would probably argue that it doesn't go into extreme depth, but it goes far enough to get you going. Given that it's around 5 or 6 dollars, it's a good read for a few nights. The down side, or up side (depending on your view) is it is somewhat short. The downside is sometimes I had a few questions that I wish were answered before going to a new topic, but at the same time it proceeds with a good pace. My personal recommendation is to spend a week and read through two or three beginner books. That being said, I'd start with this one.

Very thorough and enjoyable to read, whether for beginner or experienced grower.

This is the fifth book I've read in my short bonsai career and a pretty good one. I only read a few things that sounded off and the rest was in line with the other things I've read. It also has some new info and tips I haven't heard before. Species guide is lacking somewhat. Most of this is also covered in other books, free websites and forums so whether it's worth the \$6 is up for debate.

Very well written for the novice or someone interested in the art of bonsai. It is basic information and written to understand rather than confuse the reader! I am now comfortable enough to head to the garden center!

Pretty thoroughly covers the basics. Will be on my shelf for quite sometime.

I found that the e-book contained all you could possibly need in the way of instruction. The only other thing needed is hands on experience. The pictures are fabulous, text is easy on the eyes (at least on my computer). I downloaded the kindle app for computers just to be able to get this book.
