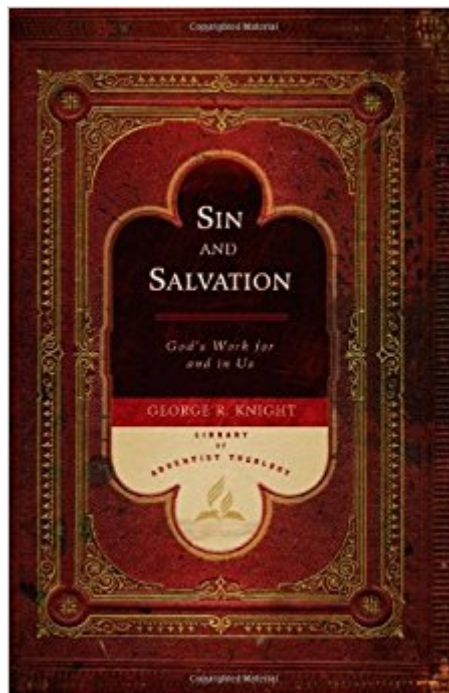




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Sin And Salvation: God's Work For And In Us (Library Of Adventist Theology)
