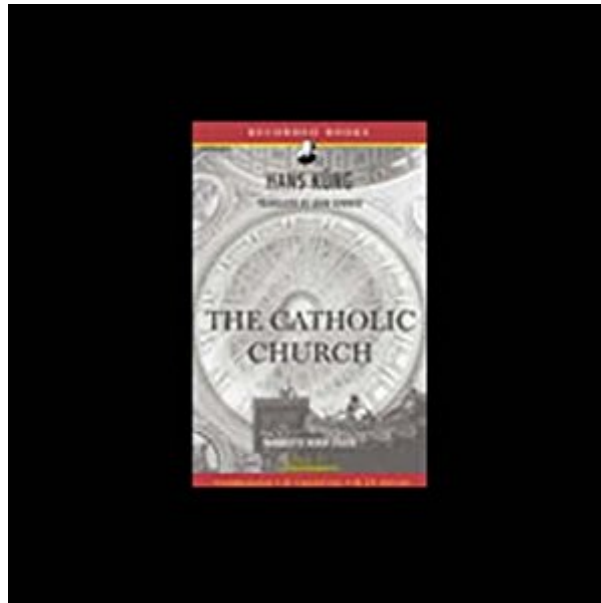

Kung's history of the Catholic Church pulls no punches. He lays bare the all too human political and dynastic maneuvering that has helped shape its history. The author's problems with the papal machinery are well known, and this book is really a history of the papacy more than of the church. It is illuminating, and quite damning, in its tracing of the evolution of the over-centralism that marks the present day Catholic Church. But as a history of the Church, it is too short on outlining the many "good things" that also are a part of the story. For all its limitations it is a recommended read!

Fr. Kung presents a refreshing look at the institutional Catholic church with a clear historical view on how certain views developed, such as papal infallibility and the primacy of the Bishop of Rome. This should be required reading matter for all Roman Catholics.

After visiting the Vatican, I had a lot of questions regarding the rise of the papacy and the evolution of the Roman Catholic church. While a Catholic scholar, Kung's book is an informative and balanced treatment. I highly recommend the book for all students of Church history.

This is an enlightening read for fellow Catholics who are interested in our true history... good and bad. Not recommended for strict adherents to the "Baltimore Catechism". Hans Kung has been and remains the premier Christian theologian of our times.
