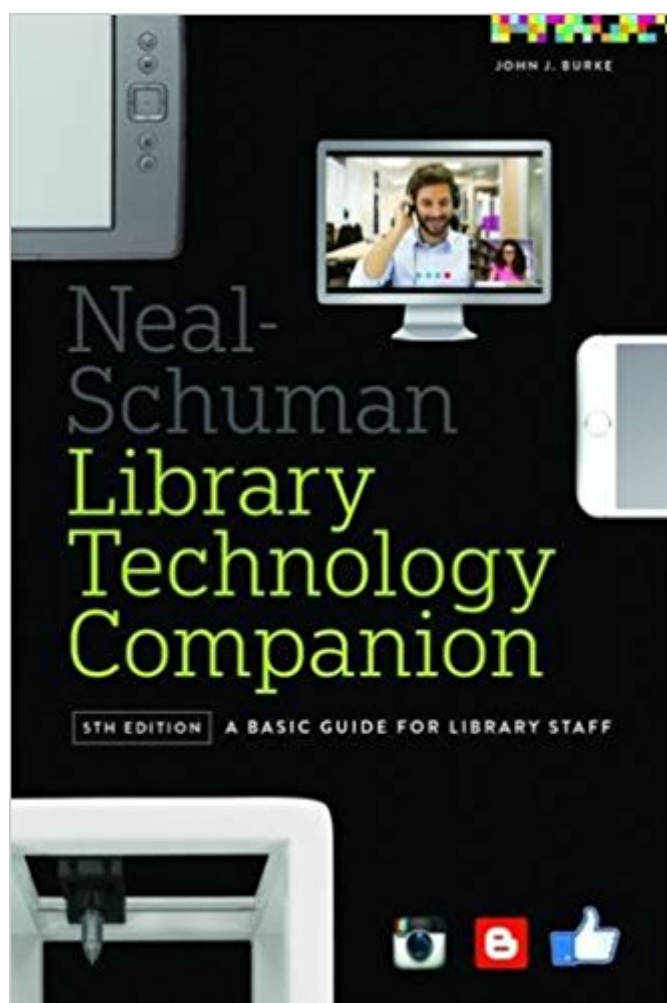

Prior to his current position, he gained a tremendous amount of experience with technology in libraries at the University of Cincinnati Raymond Walters College (Ohio) and Fairmont State College (West Virginia). He is a past president of the Academic Library Association of Ohio (ALAO) and a recipient of that organization's Jay Ladd Distinguished Service Award. He is the author of several other books, including four previous editions of *The Neal-Schuman Library Technology Companion: A Basic Guide for Library Staff*. He has presented on a variety of technology topics at conferences hosted by the Association of College and Research Libraries (ACRL) and the American Library Association (ALA), the Library Information and Technology Association (LITA) National Forum, and various regional and state conferences.

Quite a mediocre text that's outdated and lacks the in-depth information you expect in a college textbook. The short sections barely scratch the surface. There's a dearth of URLs, which could point readers to more and better information. This should be an ebook with lots of links and interaction. While I see the need to start at square one, that doesn't mean you finish at square two in a college textbook. There should be more items in the further readings section so at least we're able to find writers who have done a better job. Very expensive and disappointing.

For a technology book that discusses buying eBooks as "freeing [libraries] from buying print copies of technology book titles that become quickly outdated," (41) it would be nice to have it as an eBook version. Seriously. This is especially true because one of the best features of the book are references to other articles and information with web links. If it was an eBook, you could just follow the link directly. With print, you must type in the URL. Also, the price point should be lower than \$75 for a 200 page paperback book. I would never have bought this book, except that it was required for a college course. I'm sorry if you have to buy it.

Book is woefully short and filled with only basic information. If you aren't buying this for a textbook, I really don't suggest it at the current price. This product would be much more acceptable at around \$30 to \$40 USD or about half the current cost.
